For an authentic slice of Rat Pack history, stay at **Frank Sinatra's** former Palm Springs residence. The Twin Palms estate, designed by E. Stewart Williams in 1947, was Sinatra and **Ava Gardner's** hideaway. The crack in the bathroom sink (the result of Sinatra throwing a champagne bottle in a rage) remains, but the rest of the house has been lovingly restored with vintage designer furnishings. Mod cons, such as Wi-Fi and iPod connectivity both inside and outside, bring it bang up to date. The pool - Sinatra's design - is shaped like a grand piano.
